

Code of Conduct & Anti-Harrasment Policy

When purchasing a ticket and/or attending NextInPlay's events, you agree to adhere to our Code of Conduct that we host at our events. This is to ensure a pleasant and inclusive experience for all attendants and staff. Therefore, we set ground rules all participants should follow:

Expected/Acceptable Behaviour

1. Respectful communication and language with all parties involved.
2. Respecting boundaries, especially when having been told by people.
3. No instigating topics that are unappreciated in conversations.
4. Follow guidelines/instructions from event & venue staff.
5. The venue has a strict no external consumption policy where you cannot bring your own food into the venue. Please talk with the event or venue staff for any further questions.

Intolerable Behaviour

At NextInPlay events we hold a zero-tolerance policy when it comes to harassing, violence, intimidation and any other violating behaviours. Such actions include but are not limited to:

1. Violence towards any person during and around our community and events.
2. Racist, sexist, homophobic, transphobic, ableist speech or any other hate speech that degrades, insults or targets any one person or a group of people
3. Political hate speech or instigating
4. Sexual harassment in any way, shape or form
5. Continuous disruptions of talks or other event/community activities that worsen the experience for other participants
6. Not following event or venue staff instructions

Failure to comply could result in warning, removal and ban from current and any future events. NextInPlay reserves the right to, at any point, remove any participant from the event when conduct has been breached.

Reporting behaviour can be done in person with any event staff or through direct contact online.
